Key Highlights

- Pre-tax NAV increased by 1 cent per share during the month, primarily reflecting higher valuations for high security water entitlements across key trading zones.
- Executed a new 1,000 ML lease during March, taking Rivco's committed lease and forward percentage to 68% from 1 July 2026 (based on current contracts).
- Entitlement transaction volumes remain subdued, reflecting the likelihood that a large volume is still tied up in Government buyback tenders.
- Lower Murray spot prices ended March at ~\$390/ML before increasing to ~\$400/ML by mid-April.
- While parts of the basin received moderate rainfall during the month, dam storage levels continued to decline. Weighted-average Southern Basin dam storages declined by 1% during the month.
